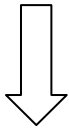
(1) The Cessna crashes into the lake with Brian and a dead pilot aboard.



(9) A rescue plane lands on the lake.



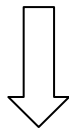

Graphic Organizer #9—Possible Answers

- (1) *The Cessna crashed into the lake with Brian and a dead pilot aboard. (Given)*
- (2) Brian finds food and builds a crude shelter.
- (3) An attack by a porcupine shows Brian the way to build a fire.
- (4) A search plane turns away without seeing Brian's signal fire.
- (5) Brian learns to catch fish and foolbirds with a spear and a bow and arrow that he invents.
- (6) Brian learns to store food on a rock ledge above his shelter and constructs a pen to hold fish.
- (7) A tornado destroys Brian's camp and exposes the tail of the Cessna.
- (8) Brian retrieves the plane's survival pack, which includes an emergency transmitter.
- (9) *A rescue plane lands on the lake. (Given)*
